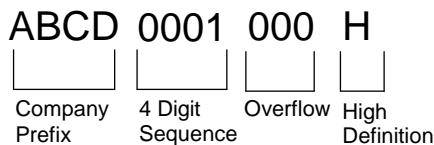

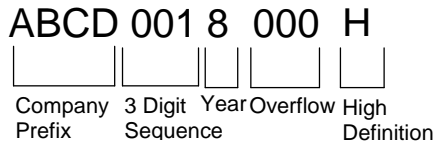
Note: Ad-ID offers the ability to customize the second set of 4 characters in Ad-ID codes issued. Please choose the format below that best fits your company's needs. If you do not have a preference, the 4 digit sequence is the most common format selected.

Format

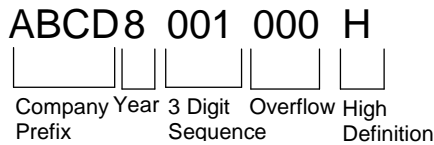
- 4 digit sequence** *(most common format selected)*
All 4 characters used for sequence, starting at 0001 and incremented from right. System assigned.
Example: ABCD 0001 0000 (sequence 0001, 0000 is Ad-ID overflow space)



- 3 digit sequence, 1 digit year**
The first 3 digits are used to count the number of Ad-IDs issued under this prefix. The last digit is the last number in the current year. System assigned.
Example (using the year 2008): ABCD 0018 0000, ABCD 0028 0000 to ABCD 9998 0000.



- 1 digit year, 3 digit sequence**
The first digit is the last number in the current year. The last 3 digits are used to count the number of Ad-IDs issued under this prefix. System assigned.
Example (using the year 2008): ABCD 8001 0000, ABCD 8002 0000 to ABCD 8999 0000.



- Custom**
This allows you to create any alphanumeric combinations for the middle 4 characters. Manually assigned at the time the Ad-ID is created.
Example: ABCD 1Y7W 0000 (custom alphanumeric 1Y7W, 0000 is Ad-ID overflow space)
